## Open to Survivors of Sexual Violence in SW Iowa

**WHO:** Survivor Link welcomes all individuals that self-identify as a survivor of sexual violence, age 13 or older, to be a part of this committee. Participants can be previous or current clients of Catholic Charities but are not required to be.

**WHAT:** Survivor Link is a time for survivors to meet other survivors, to support one another, to share about their experiences, frustrations, accomplishments, and hopes for change in the community. Survivor Link committee members will determine goals, activities, and projects upon meeting. A sexual assault advocate will be present at all meetings to provide assistance, as well. Survivor Link is simply a safe place for survivors to come together, support one another, and create change as one.

**WHEN:** Survivor Link meetings will occur on the 3rd Tuesday of every month, 5:30 pm-7:30 pm. Schedule changes will be made as needed, and notifications will be sent to committee members via email once provided.

**WHERE:** Survivor Link is hosted by Catholic Charities Domestic Violence & Sexual Assault Program. Committee meetings will take place via Zoom.
